Ross Schriftman Announces Candidacy for Wyoming House District 37

Casper, Wyo. — Ross Schriftman today announced that he is seeking the Republican nomination for Wyoming State Representative in House District 37.

“I’m running to be a watchdog for hard-working Wyoming taxpayers,” Schriftman said. “Families deserve a representative who will show up, listen, and fight for transparent spending, lower costs, and parental rights.”

In Natrona County, he regularly testifies and speaks at public meetings, serves as President of the Natrona County Chapter of Wyoming Right to Life, and is active in community service.

Schriftman is the author of the book, *My Million Dollar Mom*, which chronicles the life of his mother, Shirley, and the time when he cared for her when she had Alzheimer’s. He is also the screenwriter and producer of the award-winning film of the same name. He has completed more than 200 marathons, including the famed Boston Marathon.
